3) DOCUMENTATION, SCRUTINEERING AUDIT AND BRIEFINGS

a) Documentation

Advance Documentation will take place on Thursday evening 8 April 2021 at Auckland Car Club Clubrooms, 44 Stoddard Road, Mt Roskill, Auckland from 7:30pm

Documentation on the day of the event will take place in the Media Room on the ground floor of the Administration Building from 7:30am. Note that times for Series to report to Documentation have been listed in the Run Order. This is intended to ensure competitors qualifying early in the Run Order have completed Documentation in time to participate.

Competitors are reminded that they need to bring their current competition licence, MotorSport New Zealand Member club membership card and Vehicle Log Book to Documentation.

b) Scrutineering Audit

During the Documentation you will be advised whether your vehicle is to be subjected to audit. You should assume that your vehicle is going to be subjected to audit and as a consequence is in readiness to be taken to the audit venue immediately after you have concluded Documentation.

c) Competitors Briefing

A written briefing will be available at Documentation. A verbal briefing will not be held.

A separate briefing session will be held for new competitors. In this instance a new competitor is deemed to be a driver competing in a race meeting for the first time and a competitor who is competing at this circuit for the first time.

4) ASSEMBLY AREA AND PITS AREA

The assembly area is located behind the pit garages 1 to 16 and beside Hamptons Pavilion. You will be released from this location to commence your testing, practice qualifying or formation lap. Those leaving from pit garages will leave from pit lane under the instructions of the grid Marshalls. Vehicles leaving the pits shall not cross the yellow line as this provides a separation zone for vehicles leaving the pits to accelerate and join the circuit at the merge point.

Following the completion of your session, you will continue around the track and come into the pits via pit lane. Please come directly into the pits and do not clog pit lane for fellow competitors.

- For competitors parked in the pit garages, to return to your pit area, please continue down pit lane to your pit garage.
- For competitors not parked in the pit garages, to return to your pit area, please drive around the pit entry side of the garages (i.e. as you come off the track turn hard right and not under the middle of the garages).
- Pit lane speed in the fast lane is 40kmh – all other areas of the Pit Paddock are 15kmh. Please adhere to this for the safety of spectators and crew.
- Please note that the pit lane signalling bay on the front straight is not a viewing area and no team members, drivers or members of the public are allowed on the wall for the start of any race.

5) SCHEDULE OF QUALIFYING AND RACING

The Run Order will be finalised at the Series Coordinators meeting Thursday 8 April 2021. The final version will be emailed to all competitors on Friday 9 April. Copies will be available at Documentation.

6) GENERAL INFORMATION

a) **Fuel:**

Not more than 40 litres per car may be stored in the pit garage (keep fuel in separate locations if more than one car is in the garage). A minimum 4.5kg dry powder fire extinguisher must be available for each car in the pit garage. Fire resistant protective overalls, balaclava, gloves etc. are recommended for competitor team members refuelling the car and performing the role of the fire marshal with the fire extinguisher at the ready. Any clothing or shoes used for refuelling should be separate from any clothing or shoes worn while competing in a race vehicle. Competitors and support crew members should familiarise themselves with the WorkSafe New Zealand guide Storing and handling fuel at motorsport events dated August 2019. All competitors should be familiar with the Motorsport New Zealand Code of Practice for Motorsport Fuel.

b) **Pit Paddock Etiquette:**

- Dogs – not allowed in the internal pit paddock area
- Alcohol – there is to be no alcohol consumed in the pits until after the last event of the day.
- Cigarettes – there is no smoking in pit lane, pit garages or marquees.
- Footwear in pit lane – covered footwear must be worn in the pitlane.

Please note that children need to be supervised in the pit paddock at all times and any motorised vehicles are to be ridden and driven by license holders only. Please remember that scooters, pushbikes and skateboards are to be kept under strict control.
